This fourth and last week: 1/ visited the targeted 13

communities of the Ashanti region where we performed 200+ households' surveys 2/ initiated discussions about prospective collaboration between The Red Cross and one of our suppliers 3/ organized a debrief with senior representatives from

1st week - dedicated to 1/ discover the context of the mission, 2/ meet the different stakeholders involved: The Red Cross, Nestlé colleagues, cocoa suppliers, cocoa communities, NGO, etc. 3/ organize the next 3 weeks. 2nd week - essentially focused on training 25 volunteers on Water and Sanitation, Health and Nutrition and the methodology of the survey to be conducted during week 3 and 4 in the Nestlé cocoa farming communities of the Eastern and Ashanti regions. 3rd week - visited 38 targeted communities in the Eastern region where we performed almost 800 households' surveys.
