The **first week** has been dedicated to 1/ discover the context of the mission, 2/ meet the different stakeholders involved: Red Cross teams, Nestlé colleagues, cocoa suppliers, cocoa communities, NGO etc. 3/ organize the next 3 weeks.

The **second week** has been essentially focused on training a group of 25 volunteers on Water and Sanitation, Health and Nutrition and the Methodology of the Survey to be conducted during week 3 and 4 in the Nestlé cocoa farmers communities of the Eastern region (38 communities) and the Ashanti region (13 communities).

This **third week** we visited the 38 communities of the Eastern region where we performed almost 800 households' surveys.

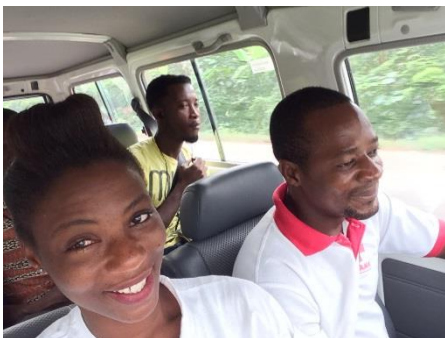
